ALAPAHA 1000 ACRE BOW HUNT



Join us for an amazing hunting experience that takes place on 1000+ acres of premium deer hunting property. The property is pristine wilderness and consists of four contiguous tracts that includes the Boy Scouts of America Camp Patten, and two miles of river frontage along the Alapaha River in Lanier County, Georgia. Only 30 hunters are allowed. Each hunter will be assigned a 25 acre hunting area. One Hunter per area. Each area is \$500.00.

Camp Patten consists of 140 acres and has never been open to hunting. 730 acres of the property are under quality deer management with no public access and only eight bucks harvested since 2006. The remaining property has had limited hunting.

Hunters will supply their own stand and safety harness. A "Hold Harmless Agreement" is required. Tree stands, tripod, ladder stands, or ground blinds are allowed. Hunters will be transported to and from stands resulting in minimum traffic on the property during the hunt.

Easy to reach, I-75, Exit 29, take Hwy 122 East 20 miles to Lakeland, GA and follow the signs.
